STANDING COMMITTEES OF THE BOARD			
Finance	Prepares the annual budget and advises the board as to the expenditure of funds.	Quarterly meetings	Interest/experience in association/non-profit budgeting and finances
Advocacy	Develops and implements a legislative program for the state.	14-16 meetings per year – mainly by conference call & attendance at Nurse Advocacy Day in February	Interest/experience in advocacy, bill review, government affairs, lobbying
Practice	Addresses nursing practice concerns and issues of health care consumers and professionals in relation to the nursing profession. Recommends policy on professional nursing issues.	4-6 meeting per year – mainly by conference call	Interest/experience in practice, administration and/or education
COMMITTEES OF THE ASSEMBLY			
Bylaws	Suggests and receives all proposed amendments to MONA bylaws. Reviews regional bylaws upon request.	2-3 meetings early in the year of membership assembly and by email on an as needed basis	Interest/experience in bylaws and organizational structure
SPECIAL COMMITTEES			
MONA PAC	Solicit funds for campaign contributions and distribute monies to selected candidates running for state offices based on established criteria.	Quarterly meetings by conference call	Interest/experience in political campaigns
Missouri Nurse Editorial Advisory Board (MoNEAB)	Works to contribute and review articles for the MONA publication, <i>The Missouri Nurse</i> .	Meets by conference call as needed – 2-3 review cycles per year	Strong review skills required and knowledge of APA style.
Advanced Practice Registered Nurses Special Interest Group (APRN-SIG)	Recommend policy positions for APRN issues; Meeting open to all APRNs who are MONA members	Quarterly meetings in person, mainly in Jefferson City	Must be advanced practice registered nurse
