HB 2072 Rep. Brandon Phelps	Subject: Workplace Violence Prevention This act modifies the offense of assault in the fourth degree. This language was developed in partnership with a county prosecutor who is interested in better protecting nurses and other healthcare workers from workplace violence. MONA's Position: <u>MONA supports this legislation.</u> Action: Contact your legislators and urge them to support this bill.
HB 2372 Rep. Tara Peters SB 841 Sen. Mike Bernskoetter	Subject: Omnibus Healthcare Bill This legislation creates a number of health-related statute changes. Changes of importance to nurses are: maternal health care and maternity services; authorization to allow school nurses and nurses' aides in long-term care facilities to use epinephrine delivery products; telehealth provisions; hospital workplace violence notifications; and insurance coverage of certain healthcare services. HB 3119 Rep. Renee Reuter SB 990 Sen. Tracy McCreery	Subject: Motorcycle Helmet Law This act requires motorcycle operators and passengers to wear protective headgear. Current law allows any qualified motorcycle operator who is aged 26 or older to operate a motorcycle or motor tricycle without wearing protective headgear. This act repeals such provision and requires every person operating or riding as a passenger on a motorcycle or motor tricycle to wear protective headgear. Patty Lewis	Subject: Transition to Practice for Advanced Practice Registered Nurses (APRNs) This act modifies provisions relating to the practice of advanced practice nursing. Under current law, collaborative practice arrangements are required between a physician and an Advanced Practice Registered Nurse (APRNs). This legislation would remove that requirement for those APRN's who have worked in a collaborative practice arrangement for a certain amount of hours with a collaborating physician. APRN's applying for licensure by endorsement may demonstrate to the Missouri State Board of Nursing completion of such hours MONA's Position: <u>MONA supports this legislation.</u> Action: Contact your legislators and urge them to support these bills.
HB 2067 Rep. David Casteel	Subject: Prescriptive Authority for APRNs This bill adds Schedule II stimulants to the prescriptive authority of an advanced practice registered nurse (APRN) who holds a certificate of controlled substance prescriptive authority.
